NASA Space Scientist Dr. Rank Nazeer Ahmed Visits Foundation

A renowned NASA scientist Dr. Nazeer Ahmad was in Delhi a few days ago. To felicitate his visit to India, Alhikmah Foundation organized a function on 23rd June 2013 at Alhikmah Education Point, Zakir Nagar, New Delhi where eminent people from academia were present along with students and concerned citizens.

After the opening remarks by Dr. Ziauddin Ahmad, Chairman of Alhikmah Foundation, Dr. Nazeer Ahmad addressed the

gathering, sharing his views on the vital issue of educational needs of developing countries. The title of his talk was 'Bridging the Education Gap' in which he focused the glaring differences between the educational modules in western societies and in India. He compared and contrasted the education systems of the developed and the developing world with special emphasis on India. He highlighted that western education system is more liberal and flexible and provides more opportunities for creative, intellectual as well as overall development of individual's personality. World Anti Tobacco Day Observed By the Foundation

The Alhikmah Foundation observed the World Anti-Tobacco Day on May 31st, 2013. On this occasion a meeting of the members of the Foundation and the concerned citizens was called at the Foundation's headquarters Alhikmah Education Point, Zakir Nagar, New Delhi. Addressing the meeting, the Founder Chairman of the Foundation Dr. Ziauddin Ahmad asserted that he failed to find any logical reason behind people taking up smoking. It is a matter of grave concern that the people gladly spend huge amount from their hard-earned on purchasing tobacco and tobacco products and throw an open invitation to life-threatening diseases. Citing from WHO he said that approximately one person dies every six seconds due to tobacco and this accounts for one in 10 adult deaths. He called upon the masses and especially the youths to say good-bye, once for all, to tobacco and tobacco products. Dr. Zia was of the view that it is worthless to blame only the government for promoting tobacco rather we

ourselves come forward to call it quits. It is the duty of each one of us to spearhead the campaign for eradication of tobacco use.

Dr. Zia called upon the voluntary sector and the NGOs to focus their attention on this serious issue and educate the masses on the harmful physical, economical and social effects of substance abuse. Referring to a Hadith (Saying) of Prophet Mohammad (Peace be Upon Him) Dr. Zia emphasized that the Prophet Mohammad (Peace be Upon Him) has directed the Muslims to refrain from the narcotics. Dr. Zia reminded that we are role-models for the younger generation. Therefore, it is imperative on us not to indulge in any hazardous practice because children imitate us. And if they take to tobacco and tobacco products the blame would squarely lie on us. On this occasion a resolution was passed by the Foundation asking the government to frame stringent laws to discourage smoking and liquor consumption.
