

Renowned sociologist, author and former professor of Jawaharlal Nehru University (JNU) Prof. Imtiaz Ahmad passed away on 19th June 2023. Prof. Ahmad is known for his works on caste in Islam. He worked with keen interest in social anthropology and taught Sociology and Political Science in various universities in India and abroad.

Born in 1940, Prof. Ahmad completed his graduation and post graduation from Lucknow University. He won the Pandit Jagpal Krishna Gold Medal from Lucknow University in 1960. He was a Fellow at the South Asia Centre, University of Chicago and a Senior Fellow of Indian Council of Social Sciences, New Delhi.

He had been associated with Alhikmah Foundation since the beginning and was a patron of the foundation. He had always provided the foundation with his valuable guidance and expertise in different walks of work.
